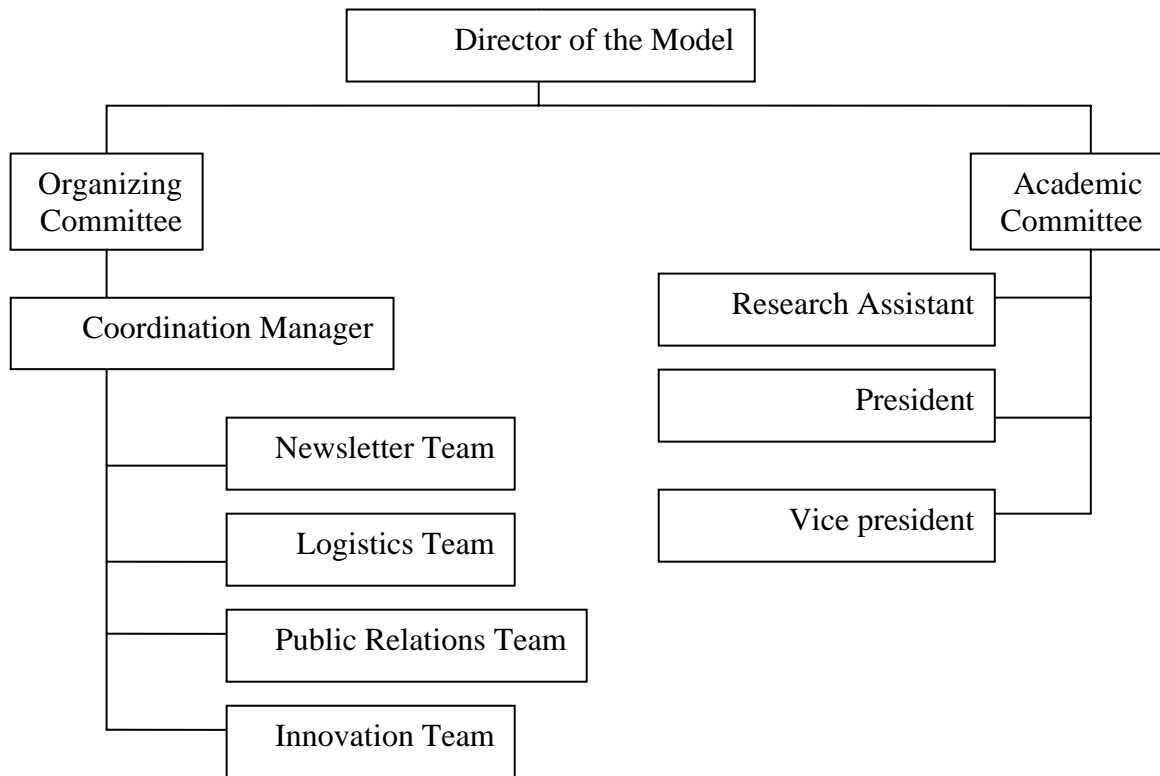
AIMUN team believes in human rights and equity, so we believe that any human being regardless his religion, color, sex, or race has the right to get equal treatment in everything.

Guidelines for the sessions:**1- Time:**

- b- Not be afraid to challenge. This is achieved by asking good questions, avoid making judgments, focusing on ideas, and refraining from personal attacks.
- c- Unnecessary obscenity or use of vulgar language will be considered as an offence.
- d- Dehumanizing and discriminatory language as outlined in our definition of human rights is also an offence.
- e- Any threat of bodily harm that is clearly stated or implied will not be tolerated.
