Outside the experimental team of the GYCA and the members of the GYCA and the national youth networks, as partners and guides always appointed to us in the implementation of the programs of the GYCA in Ivory Coast:

- Movements Student of Sensitization against the AIDS (MESSI)
- Ivorian network of the Young people against the AIDS
- The community youth groups

My priorities were multi-form of such signboard as I wanted to be and to associate with all the meetings relative to the HIV / AIDS and, to make my voice listen because it was the best means to become known the GYCA. The accomplished progress is that the GYCA was recognized by several networks national of fight against the HIV / AIDS such as the Network of the Professionals and Media against the HIV / AIDS (REPMASCI), the Coordination of the Organizations of fight against the HIV / AIDS (COSI) and the Alliance of the Monks against the HIV / AIDS and the other Pandemics (ARSIP), the international, national institutions and the community groups.

My biggest fulfillments in my qualities of NFP are thus the association of the GYCA in all the events HIV and the presentation of the GYCA to organizations occurring in Ivory Coast and especially the distribution of information which I shared with more than 5000 young people.

My work with the GYCA has still allowed me to include; that it is not easy to manage a group and when certain members do not adhere to it or do not share the same vision as you. But I am delighted at it of the fact that I learnt to contribute to fight against the HIV on an international scale, to share information of raising awareness to reduce the infection of the HIV within the young communities and especially the acquisition a luggage of brave leader having represented his country with a large-scale organization as Global Youth Coalition on HIV / AIDS.

The obstacles are always enormous and allow reaching his objectives. Often confront with fits of jealousy with the national network of the young people who thought that the GYCA came to blur them tracks with the UNFPA thus I decide on it to put an end to our collaboration. After several put down mails and phone calls in the UNAIDS without continuation; I preferred to abandon and to direct me to international organizations as the PEPFAR, World Fund, UNICEF and the others. I was able to recover thanks to the support of LEROUX Elise, executive director of the RIJES, Yvette NTAMON, executive director of the ARSIP who put back me contacts or I called the secretariat of certain organization for meeting setting or I went to events without being invited what allowed me to seek a meeting with the senior officials of international institutions learnt at their convenience.

To reach my objectives; financial resources are needed because without financial means you will can nothing because it is difficult to seek or to retain young people without means. But I wish that it is provided us with that that a financial subsidy which will allow to be more operational.

### **A) - Conference on the Communication for the Change of Behavior and responsible at the school**

The conference on the Communication for the Change of Behavior and responsible at the school organized to the middle school THE COURS SOCIAUX of the municipality of ABOBO in the district of Abidjan gathered 150 pupils among whom 95 girls and 55 boys whose proposition of the age varies between 10 and 21 years. In the term of the conference; we proceeded to the installation of a Club HIV / AIDS which will be our relay with their companions and communities.

### **B) - Radio Transmission Contribution of the TIC in the fight against the young HIV / AIDS in environment**

The radio transmission (Contribution of the TIC in the fight against the young HIV / AIDS in environment) takes place in the studios of the Radio Abidjan 1FM livened up by Madam Awa GUEDEGUE (Communicator in Development to the UNICEF/ Ivory Coast) and as guests SORO Gaël, National Focal Point of Global Youth Coalition on HIV / AIDS / Ivory Coast and Eric Zayé GNAOULE, member of Movements Student of Sensitization against the AIDS (MESSI). During one hour, each of the guests made an analysis then propositions or plea in aid of the companies of mobile telephones, the suppliers of internet, the managers of the clubs of internet, and especially the young people who these clubs with strong mobilization. The technician received the phone calls of five auditors among which two men and three women.

### **C) - Training of the community Presenters and the superintendents of the National Day of Councils and Screenings with HIV / AIDS (JNCD)**

In prelude of the National Day of Councils and Screening to HIV / AIDS; the parish Saint Xavier François in the municipality of ABOBO served as place of training of the community presenters all

coming NGO occurring in this municipality. 60 persons were trained for the sensitization of mass in sight 06 persons on 10 as trainers the honorary grown-up friend of which 35 women and 25 men distributes coordinating Mr. BERTE Zanga of the (JNCD) and Madam Hortense, alive person with the HIV and the member of the Ivorian Network persons alive with the HIV (RIP+).

The following modules were livened up:

- Majorities on the HIV / AIDS
- Promotion of the Council Screening
- Basic notion on the Community Mobilization
- Orientation on the guide of community mobilization and the tools of collection of data.

Evaluation and affectation of 60 presenters on ten sites identified with Abobo.

The training was very participative and dynamic both towards the presenters and the livened up which especially demonstrated during the training course that we could count with them to make correctly the work of sensitization of mass.

## D) - National Day of Councils and Screenings with (HIV / AIDS)

The district of Abidjan having in its asset 10 municipalities where I intervened allowed me to have the balance sheet calculated by the positive and negative detected persons of the National Day of Councils and Screening to ABOBO.

### **E) - Seminary of Training of the Leaders of organization of Young people in Sexual and reproductive Health and in rights of the Child.**

In the term of the training, the RIJES put back diploma of participation so that to continue us the restructuring with our respective organizations or communities.

Hanging all the August; the Student Movement of Sensitization AIDS associated National Focal Point to its awareness campaign through all the student halls of residence of the district of Abidjan (CAMPUS of COCODY, RIVIERA 2, ADJAME 220, ADJAME WILLIAMSWILLE, ABOBO 1 and 2, QUOTED COCODY RED, MERMOZ, PORT(BEARING) BOUET, VRIDI 1 AND 2).

## **G) - Screening Film Discussion**

Within the framework of the project «Love in The Time of HIV », National Focal Point is delighted to coordinate and to organize the activities of the GYCA in collaboration with aids2031. For that purpose, I organized several projections within various communities among which the Moslem community, the Catholic community, the Protestant, evangelic community and the schools.

On 20th November 2009 in collaboration with the FOUNDATION DJIGUIYA which intervenes with the Moslem community; allowed in National Focal Point to go to MARCORY SANS FIL exactly in the municipality of MARCORY with a community which has pleased our initiative.

There were persons of all the ages T-shirt as motive for encouragement and for congratulation of which a number of 103 persons answering pertinently our questions so thus I put back to them. Concerning the spending of this night; the sound system cost 47 \$, running 10 \$ for my car which transported us, phone card 10 \$ and approximately 100 chairs 15 \$.
