Learning Network Day

Logistical Arrangements

MTR

The best MTR stations for transport to HKUST are:

- Choi Hung
- Hang Hau
- Po Lam

From either of them, you can then board a bus, minibus or taxi that lets you off at the main entrance of HKUST.

Bus/Minibus

There are many buses to HKUST, most of them leave from different MTR stations and bus terminals.

From Choi Hung bus terminus: 1S minibus
From Choi Hung MTR station: 91 or 91M bus; 11 or 11S minibus
From Hang Hau MTR station: 91M bus; 11, 11M or 11S minibus
From Ngau Tau Kok MTR station: 104 minibus
From Po Lam MTR station: 91M bus; 12 minibus
From Sai Kung bus terminus: 792M bus; 12 or 1S minibus
From Tiu Keng Leng MTR station: 792M bus
The buses let passengers off at the main entrance.

Taxi

Taxis provide a simple way to get to the University, and are easily available at any MTR station, from hotels and most areas of Hong Kong. From the airport, you can expect to pay approximately HK\$380 (about US\$49) for the journey.
From the Hang Hau MTR, taxi fare is approximately HK\$ 25; from the Choi Hung MTR, approximately HK\$ 50. Taxis will let you off either at the main gate, or at the Entrance Piazza.

Parking

Please send us your car plate number if you plan to arrive by car, so we can arrange the free parking for you. The car park fees are \$10 per hour for the first 2 hours and \$50 per hour after.

General Driving Directions

From Hong Kong Island : Take the Eastern Harbour Crossing towards Lam Tin. Continue straight after the roundabout, and get in the right lane towards the Tseung Kwan O Tunnel, following signs for Hang Hau. At the roundabout for Hang Hau, take the Ying Yip Road exit, following the road past the Clearwater Bay Film Studio onto Clearwater Bay Road. Turn right at the gas station and Shaw House. Go straight and you

will be at the Southern entrance to HKUST, the location of the public car park. Do not go to Southern entrance; instead, continue on Clear Water Bay, past Tai Po Tsai, veer right on the round-about and use the main entrance of HKUST
From Kowloon : Take Prince Edward Road towards

Kwun Tong; after Choi Hung Estates, stay left and follow signs to Clearwater Bay. Take Clearwater Bay road, go past Tai Po Tsai and turn left at the signs for Shaw House and TVB. Go past both buildings and you will be at the Southern entrance of HKUST

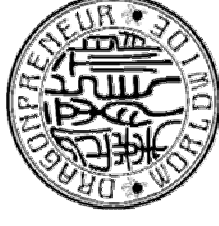
